


HVAC control **Rebates**

Help your building run more efficiently and reduce maintenance costs



Available for gas and electricity customers in both new construction and retrofit installations, you could qualify for rebates from \$40 to \$1,500 on select connected thermostats, domestic hot water recirculation controls and hydronic additives to help commercial buildings run more efficiently and reduce maintenance costs.

Connected thermostats

Connected thermostats connect to Wi-Fi or a building management system. This allows your operators to adjust temperatures on the fly—even remotely—so you can be sure your space heating and cooling systems are only running when the building is occupied.

Domestic hot water recirculation controls

Most buildings have hot water systems that run 24/7. Meaning water is being heated even when there's no demand for it. By putting a control on your domestic hot water pump, it will only run if someone turns on a hot water tap. Hot water recirculation controls provide hot water instantly on demand and may help reduce your water heating costs.

Hydronic additives

While not a typical building control, hydronic additives are chemical additions to heating systems that improve the system's heat transfer efficiency. For buildings with hydronic heating systems, this small change can have a big impact on reducing the overall energy use in the building.

- recreation centres

- manufacturing facilities
- office buildings
- commercial kitchens
